Description: The weekend workshop begins Thursday evening at 6:00pm and ends on Sunday evening at 9:00pm. The weekend includes group workshops, private lessons, practice sessions, a Friday evening concert given by the clinician, a Saturday evening student recital, Sunday group or private sessions and an evening attendance to the Tom Grant jam session at Tommy O's in Vancouver, WA . You will have the opportunity to share your music with others, but it is not required. Topics included in the workshops and lessons will include improvising, song writing, performance anxiety and topics of your choice.

Cost & Payment requirements:

Tuition is \$750.00 for the event. A *non-refundable deposit* of \$150.00 is required to save your workshop spot (space is limited to 9 attendees.) The deposit is due with the registration form and will consider you registered and committed to this event. This deposit will be applied to the tuition. The remaining balance of \$600.00 is due two weeks prior to the commencement of the workshop.
